What's so new about The Performance – Based Diploma Program (PBDP)

PBDP students use computers to master the academic part of their curriculum!

PBDP students learn occupational skills in a chosen vocational field!

PBDP students participate in individualized and small group counseling to learn leadership and decision-making skills!

PBDP students are paired with adult mentors who provide support, reinforce the importance of education, and assist in the exploration of career options.

Benefits of the Performance-Based Diploma Program

Through the Performance-Based Diploma Program:

You will earn graduation credits accelerating at your own pace

You will earn a regular high school diploma

You will develop vocational skills

You will improve social and problem solving skills

Curriculum

Performance-Based Diploma Program students are enrolled in a combination of state-required academic courses for graduation and a vocational program which prepares the student for employment in a chosen occupational area. The academic areas are computer assisted instruction which permits students to progress at their own pace. Students are mainstreamed into other courses offered at each high school.
