**Proficiency!**

**Culture** - work here is designed to help you understand the people in Germany (their history, values, beliefs, and customs) also why they do some things differently than you and how you can blend in with their society when you are abroad.

**Culture Day Presentation** REQUIRED

Complete yellow research and presentation worksheet and use the script on testing day. Max of 100 points.

**YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**Q&A Brochure.** Turn your culture research into a professional looking tri/quad-fold brochure.

**PowerPoint Presentation.** Turn your culture research into a professional looking PP product.

**Webquest** On-line research and product.

**Play an Instrument** Play something classical or popular.

**Make an Art Project** May be entered in the State Competition.

**Cook a Meal** Treat your family! See the canary yellow German **Kultur** Webpage for details.

**Immersion Learning** - The

Rosetta Stone Computer Program is designed to have you learning German like you would if you were really in Germany. It will develop all 7 of your skills at the same time. Do as much as you can!!

**Rosetta Stone. REQUIRED**

Every passing lesson is worth 20 points. Minimum of 3 is required (min.=5 for IB and DE). You are encouraged to complete 10 lessons or 1 unit every quarter in order to finish the program by the end of your 4th year. Take handwritten notes and read the worksheets.

**Writing** - these assignments will help you learn to communicate your message successfully.

**Impromptu Essay** REQUIRED

Follow the blue instructions and complete all the blue worksheets.

Max of 100 points.

**YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**Blog** Post your final essay and respond to at least 2 other class blogs. 40 word minimum for each.

**German poem** Write your own poem following the guidelines.

Work will be posted on the Internet.

**Song lyrics.** Write your own song following the word requirements for the poem.

**Penpal Letter** Join the LetterNet program.

**Speaking/Pronunciation** - Your work here will make you sound like a native speaker and help you feel confident speaking German.

**Rosetta Stone Pronunciation Test** REQUIRED

Follow the red instructions.. 500 points for 10 correct (400 for 9, etc.). Must retake test until you score at least a 6/10.

**YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**Movie.** Turn your required essay into a movie. Follow the instructions on-line. Products are posted on the Internet.

**Photo Story.** Turn your essay into a visual, multi-media product. Products will be posted on the Internet.

**Poem.** Memorize and present the assigned poem or your original poem. Number of stanzas per quarter are assigned by level.. The entire poem in quarter 4 is worth up to 100 pts. per stanza.. Original poems can be posted on-line. Daytona participants must do this assignment.

**Speech.** Present your essay orally to the teacher.

**Sing.** Sing a German song or part of the poem. Must be as long as the poem requirement.

**Grammar** - developing this ability polishes and makes all your other skills shine. This work can make you a Pro!

**GIF/Amsco Texts** REQUIRED

Every completed & corrected chapter is worth 200 points. 3 chapter minimum is required. Try to complete 6 chapters every quarter. (Pre-IB1 must do 6 per quarter. Level 2 has 5 chapters). Honors 3&4 does 600pts. worth of grammar. DE & IB must complete all assignments from both **Amsco** texts.

**YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**GIF Optional Activities** As listed on your grammar assignment sheets.

**Grammar Songs:** sing the helpful grammar songs as posted on our website.

**Reading & Vocabulary** - words

are the building blocks of any language. These assignments will build your word power and help you understand the German you see

**Flashcards** REQUIRED

Choose a German article/printed text related to your Kultur presentation and make flashcards for every word.. Max of 100 pts.

**YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**Text-Analysis.** Complete a text-analysis worksheet for your German article.

**Crossword Puzzle.** Ask your teacher for one.

**Podcast.** Use your article to create a bilingual, online editorial/news report.
