GRAMMAR INSTRUCTIONS

Setting Up

- Step 1: Get out your picture ID, and take it to the teacher's desk
- Step 2: Trade your ID for a German Is Fun Textbook or Answer Key
- Step 3: Get out your green assignment sheet and some loose leaf paper
- Step 4: Label your loose-leaf with the proper headings

Working

- Step 5: **READ** the assigned pages **before** attempting any of the exercises that follow. Check your green assignment sheet to see which exercises you need to do.

- Step 6: Label your loose leaf paper every day with the date and chapter and exercise letter/number. Don't write on the back side!

- Step 7: Work on this until you get to the end of the chapter. Don't leave an exercise blank, try it! Remember to raise your hand when you get stuck.

- Step 8: When you finish a chapter, double check that you didn't skip any exercises.

- Step 9: Trade in your textbook for an answer key

Correcting

- Step 10: Flip through the answer key until you get to the chapter you just finished. Find the first written exercise you did and **using only a red pencil**, change your answers to match those in the answer key. Don't erase anything. **Mark "OK" in the margin if you didn't have anything to correct** (this doesn't happen often). You may not copy answers, only correct what you wrote!

- Step 11: Continue through the assigned chapters in this same way.

Turning in your packet

- Step 12: When the chapter has been completed and corrected, check that you have everything labeled correctly. Re-read the *Kulturecke* and be prepared to summarize it orally. Call the teacher over to you to review the chapter, ask questions and earn your points.
