10 Steps to a Successful Oral

1. Find a text or picture or object that has sparked your interest (Ab Intio must use a picture about school, food, public communications, home, weather, environment, health or a leisure activity,- that is culturally related to German and different every quarter).
2. Research your topic on-line in English and German. Print out 2 specific texts (1 native German text and 1 native English text).
3. Create a vocabulary list of at least 25 key words relating to your topic.
4. Write a draft in German of what you would like to tell the class. This must contain: 3 cohesive devices (6 for HL), 1 idiom (2 for HL), 1 subjunctive- würde/hätte/wäre (3 for HL), 1 simple past (2 for HL). Circle/highlight them on your paper in a contrasting color (include a key)
5. Add a German title, your name, and date due (on this form below),
6. Make an index card that has with no more than 10 key words/short phrases (no complete sentences or clauses).
7. Staple everything above in order
8. Present your topic to the class (check on the quarter presentation date)
9. Turn in this packet on the day of your presentation when finished presenting
10. Celebrate! You just gave a speech, all in German!
